Strong currents bring this site to life.



One of the most beautiful and healthy staghorn reef we dive in the mergui archipelago. It's actually a huge fish nursery of the most common juvenile species, you can find regularly the long nose filefish (3cm big, don't bumb into it)as well as Hawksbill turtles, the jensy colourfull pipefish and let's not forget the Barramundi Grouper. It is in addition an excellent dive site for a night dive.

The afternoon can be spend on land excursions to search for horn bills, monkeys, butterflys and other flora and fauna.

Reef type:	Slooping reefs
Access:	Live-aboard boat from Phuket or Ranong
Visibility:	Visibility is fair to good.
Current:	Strong currents often run, but there are sheltered areas.
Coral:	staghorn up to 6 species sqm
Fish:	Abundant
Highlights:	fish nursery, ghostpipe fish, longnose file fish, Hawksbill turtles.

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
